About the College

University College was established in 1249 and currently has approximately 600 students and 250 staff. The main site is situated in the centre of Oxford on the High Street. The College also has satellite buildings at Staverton in North Oxford and a Sportsground on Abingdon Road.

Being one of the oldest Colleges in Oxford, we pride ourselves on upholding tradition and values of Oxford, whilst constantly looking to develop our offer to move with trends and dining on the High Street. On a daily basis, the kitchen produces food for around 350 students, staff and visitors through the buttery and serves a 3 course Formal plated dinner twice a week.

The Role

The senior Chef de Partie is a key role in the kitchen, working alongside a team of chefs, kitchen porters and the Catering team, including the Front of House staff. Together we provide first class catering through the year.

The food is produced in our main, recently refurbished kitchen on in University College. The business is busy all year round, except for our Christmas closure, and serves food across 4 dining areas through the day. In addition to traditional College business we cater for summer schools, weddings and conferences
